From the President:

By the time you read this newsletter our It's Magic show will be in the books. Thanks to Dennis Alm for putting together his first show as producer and for having such a great line-up. Thanks to all who bought tickets, hung posters, shared social media posts and spread the word. Our last lecture by Nathan Coe Marsh had some original content and I liked the way he added the psychology behind the performance of the effects. I noticed that during his explanations he threw out a lot of names of other magicians, some of that was to show where his inspiration came from and to also show he wasn't stealing another person's work.

For our newer magicians, when you hear those names mentioned in a lecture it might be good to write them down and do a little research to find out who they were. One of the aspects of being a magician is knowing about the history of magic and passing that knowledge on to future generations. It's just like studying art and knowing who Picasso, Rembrandt, Michelangelo and others are – no they weren't just Ninja Turtles.

This month we also have John Carey from England coming to lecture on Friday, September 20th. I've purchased a few of John's effects from Penguin Magic downloads and he explains them very well. Next month we have a Magic Jam coming up on October 8 and then a lecture by Bill Wisch on Wednesday, October 23. Bill was a protégé of Slydini and is the only person ever authorized by Slydini to teach his methods. Many of our newer magicians may not know who Slydini was.

Tony Slydini (September 1, 1901, Foggia, Italy – January 15, 1991). His mastery, expertise, originality and innovative approach to close-up magic earned him a legendary reputation in the magic world. For his work, he received the highest honors that the magical community could bestow, including both the coveted Masters Fellowship Award and Performing Fellowship Award from the Academy of Magical Arts. During his lifetime, Tony Slydini was inducted into the Society of American Magicians Hall of Fame as a Living Legend.

For the Magic Jam – this is a new event we're trying, and I want you to come hang out with your fellow members. We'll meet from 6:00 – 8:30, have pizza and drinks, and "jam" : learning, performing & camaraderie (in other words it's a chance to get to know each other). It's open to all levels of magic enthusiasts, from beginners to hobbyists to seasoned pros. Bring your cards, coins, sponge balls, or just your appetite. If you want to practice (perform) your contest act or a new routine and get some feedback it'll be a great time to do it.
